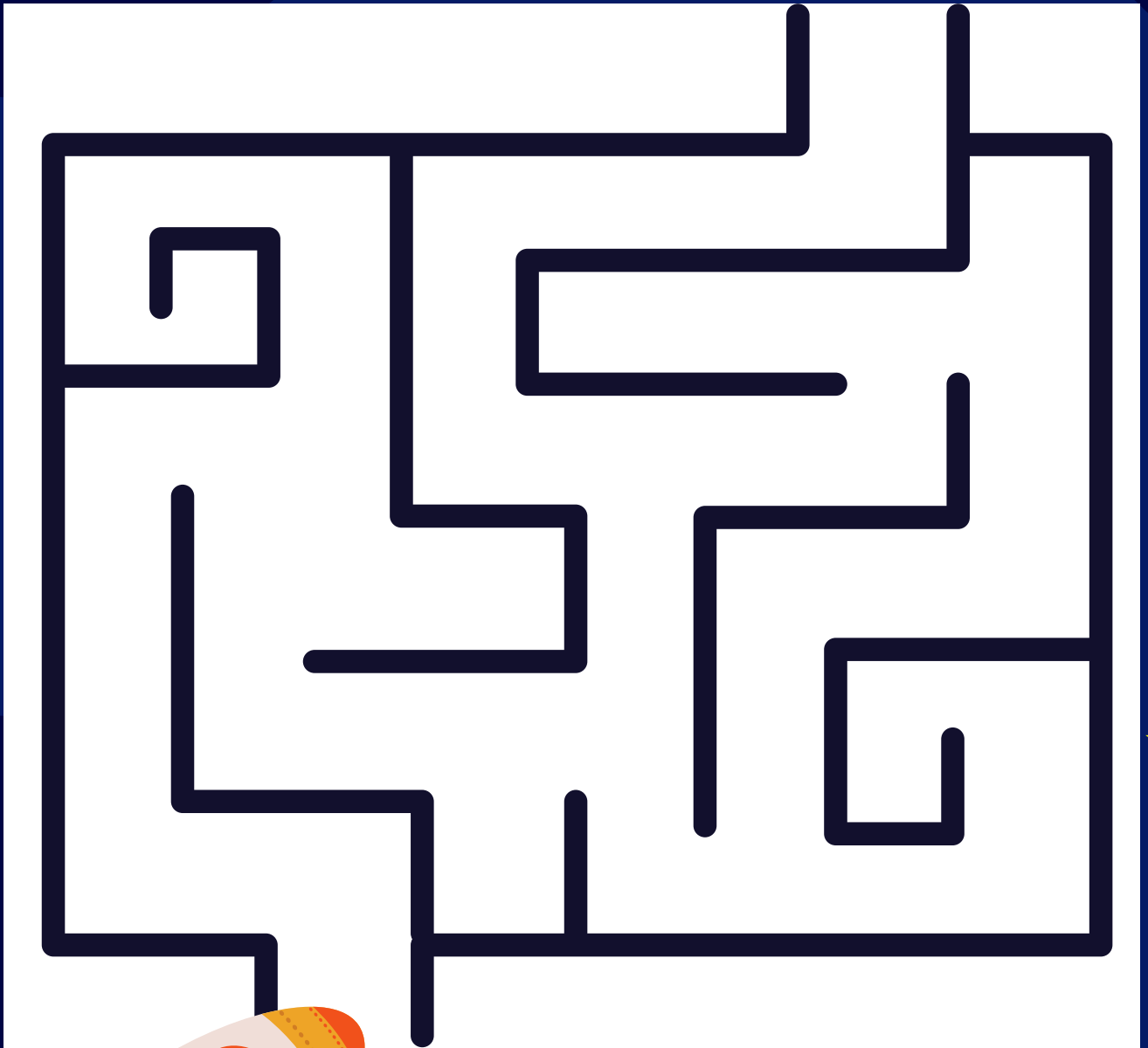

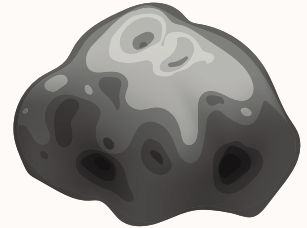

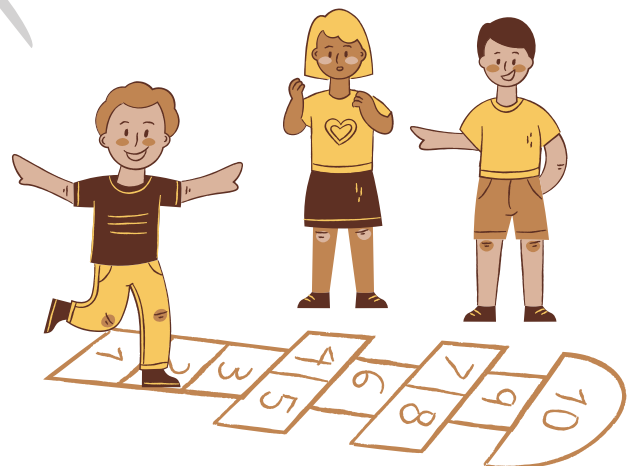


Stars form patterns. One of the famous star patterns is the "Big Dipper". Let us see how it looks like.



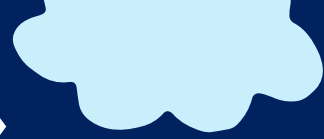

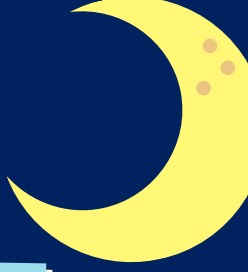

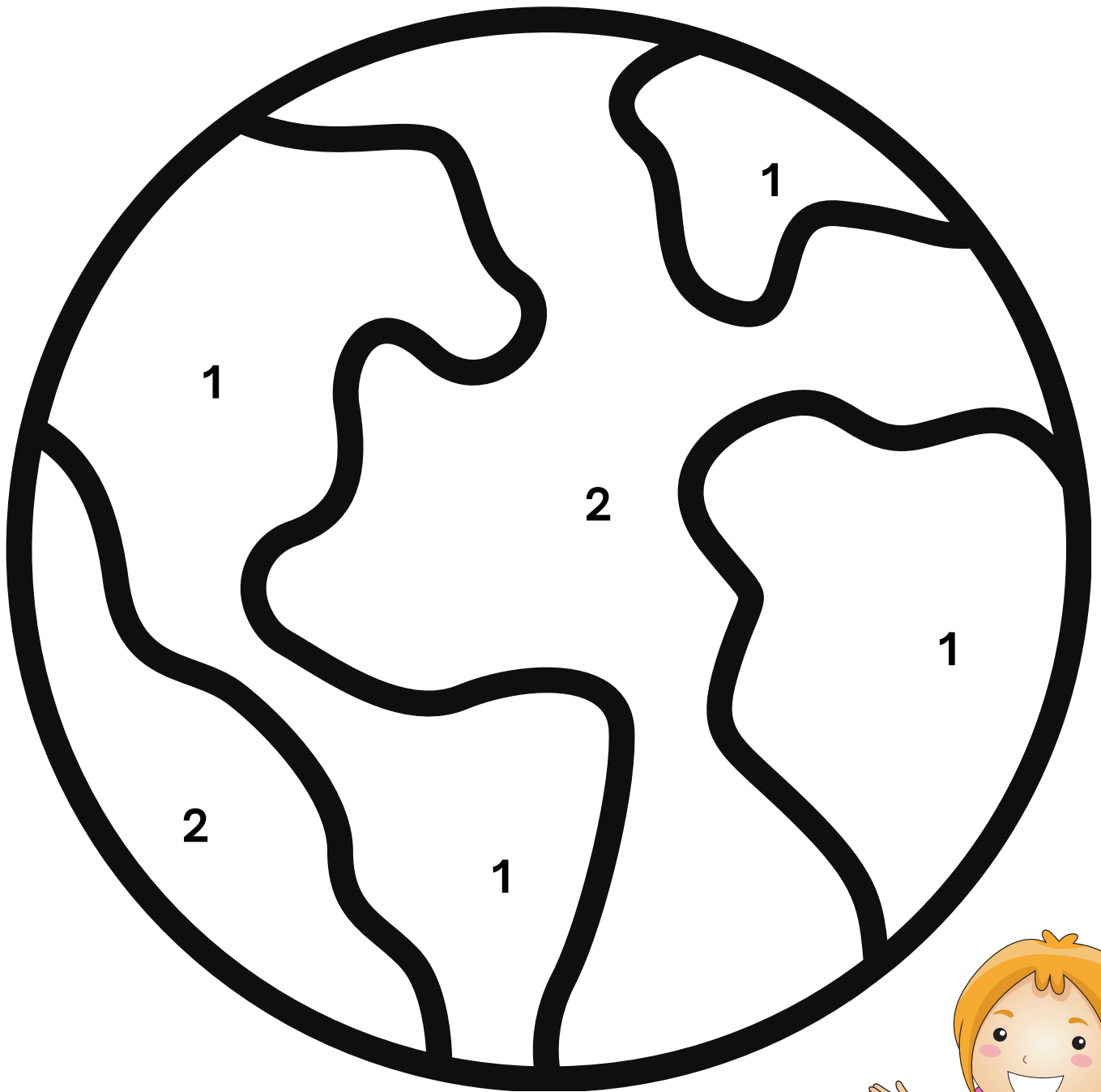




Our Planet
