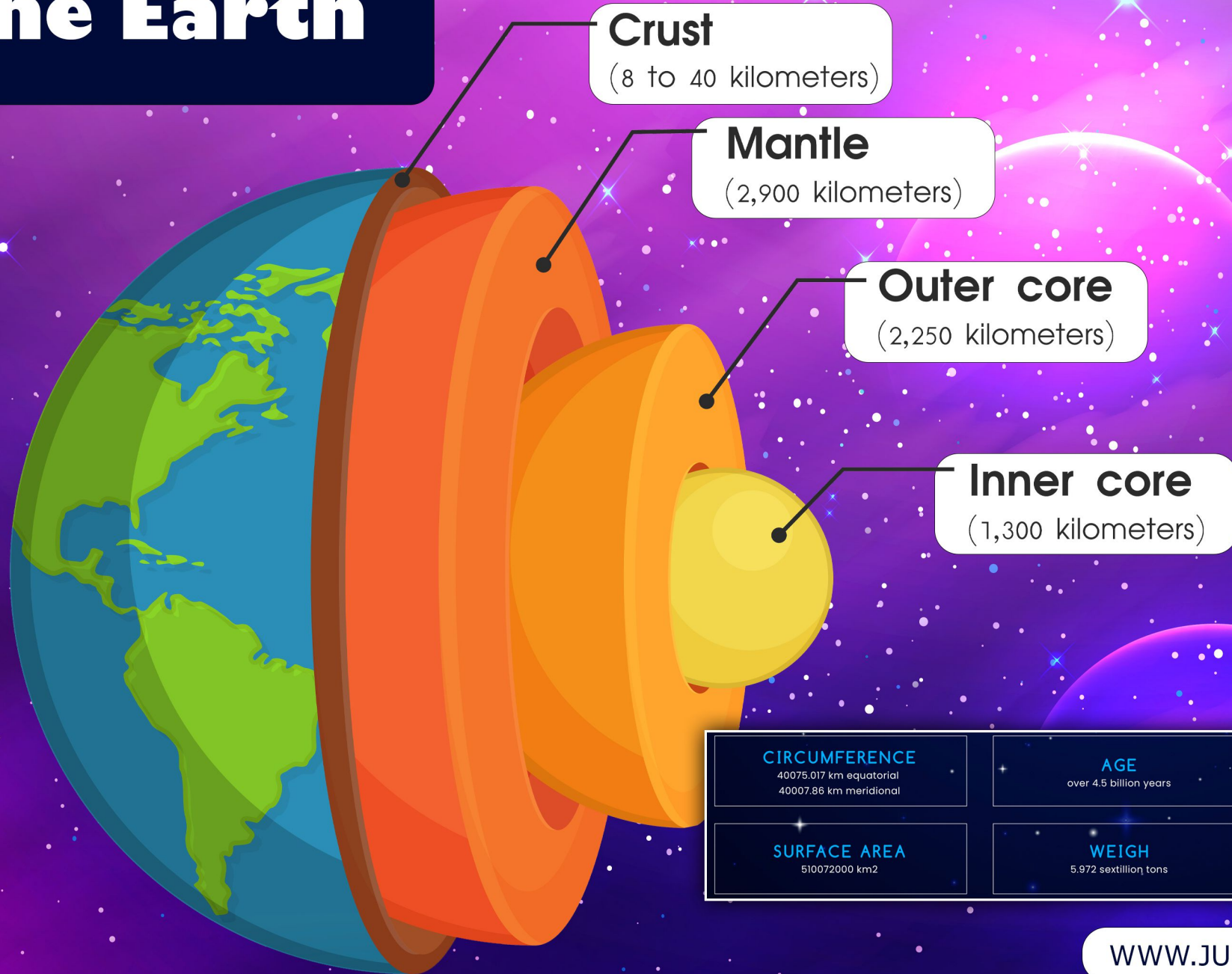


Layers of the Earth

Is the third planet from the Sun and the only astronomical object known to harbor life. 71% of Earth's surface is covered with water, the remaining 29% is land. The combination of Earth's distance from the Sun, physical properties and geological history have allowed life to evolve and thrive, today 7.7 billion humans live on Earth and depend on its biosphere and natural resources for their survival.

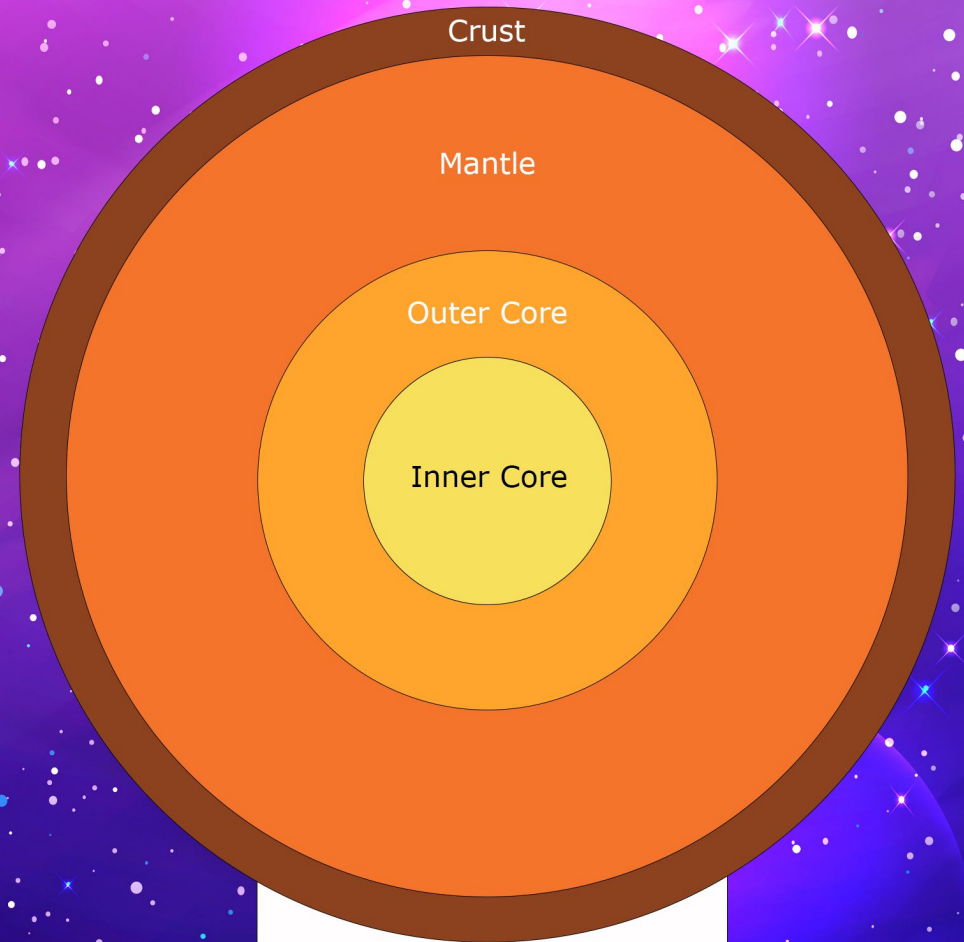

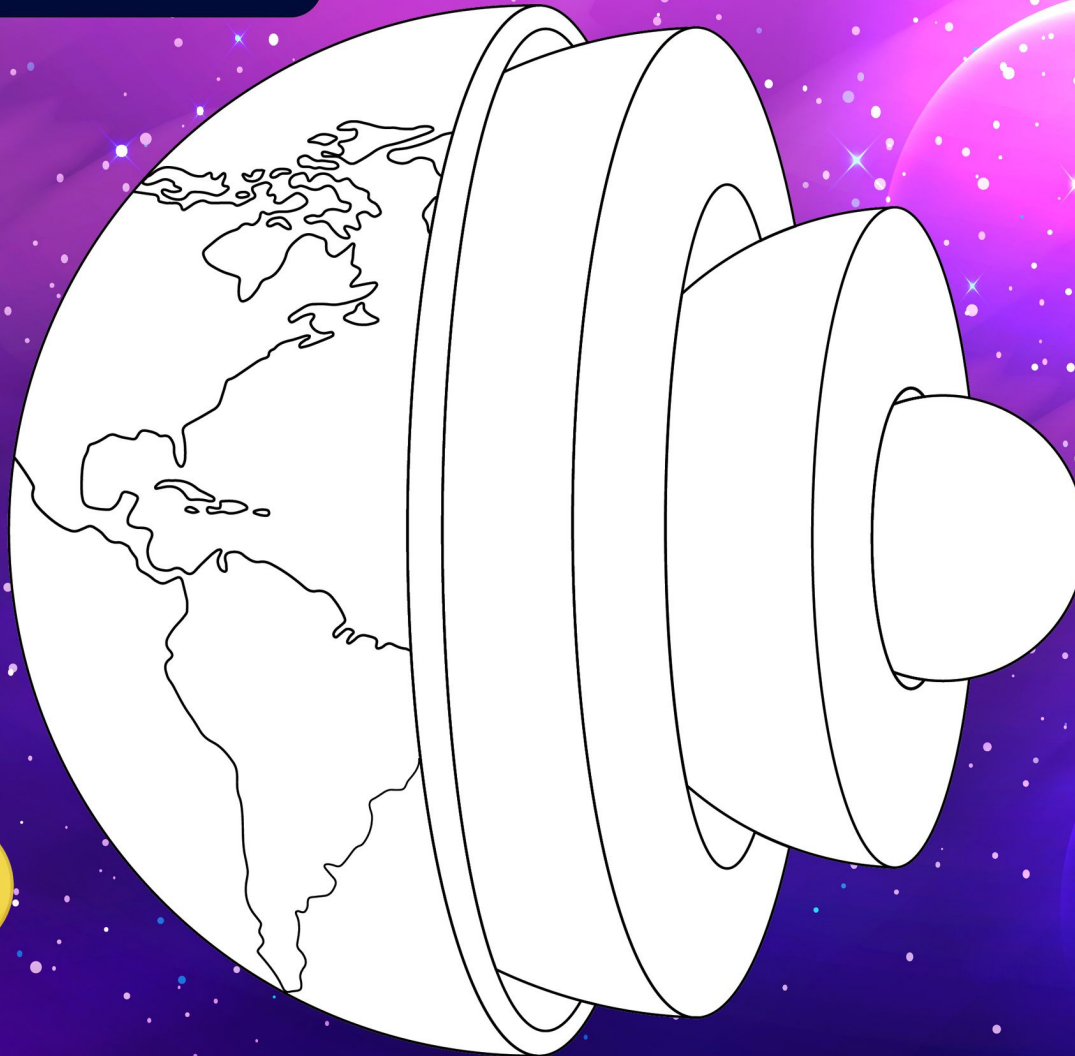
