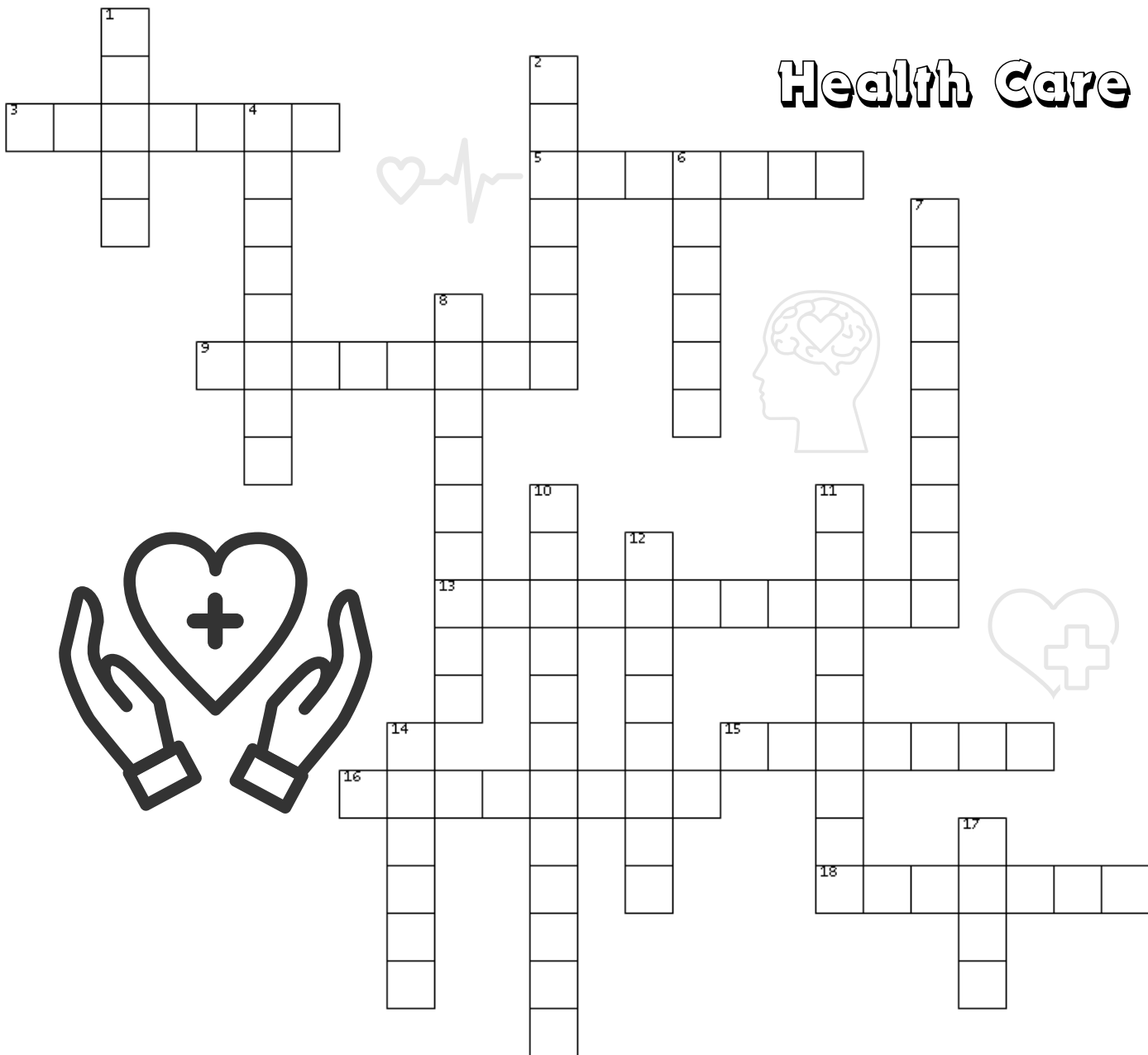

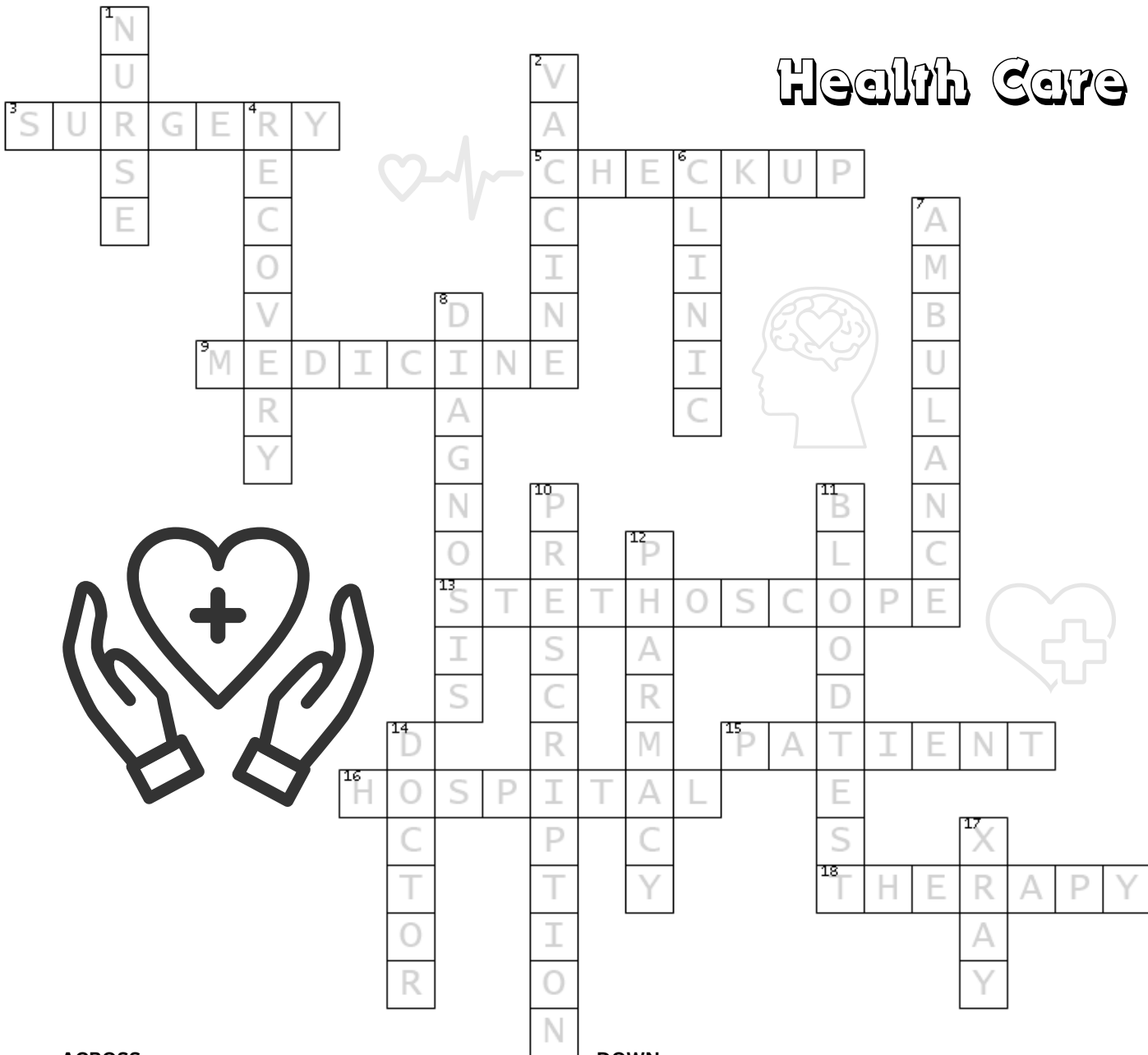
## **ACROSS**
