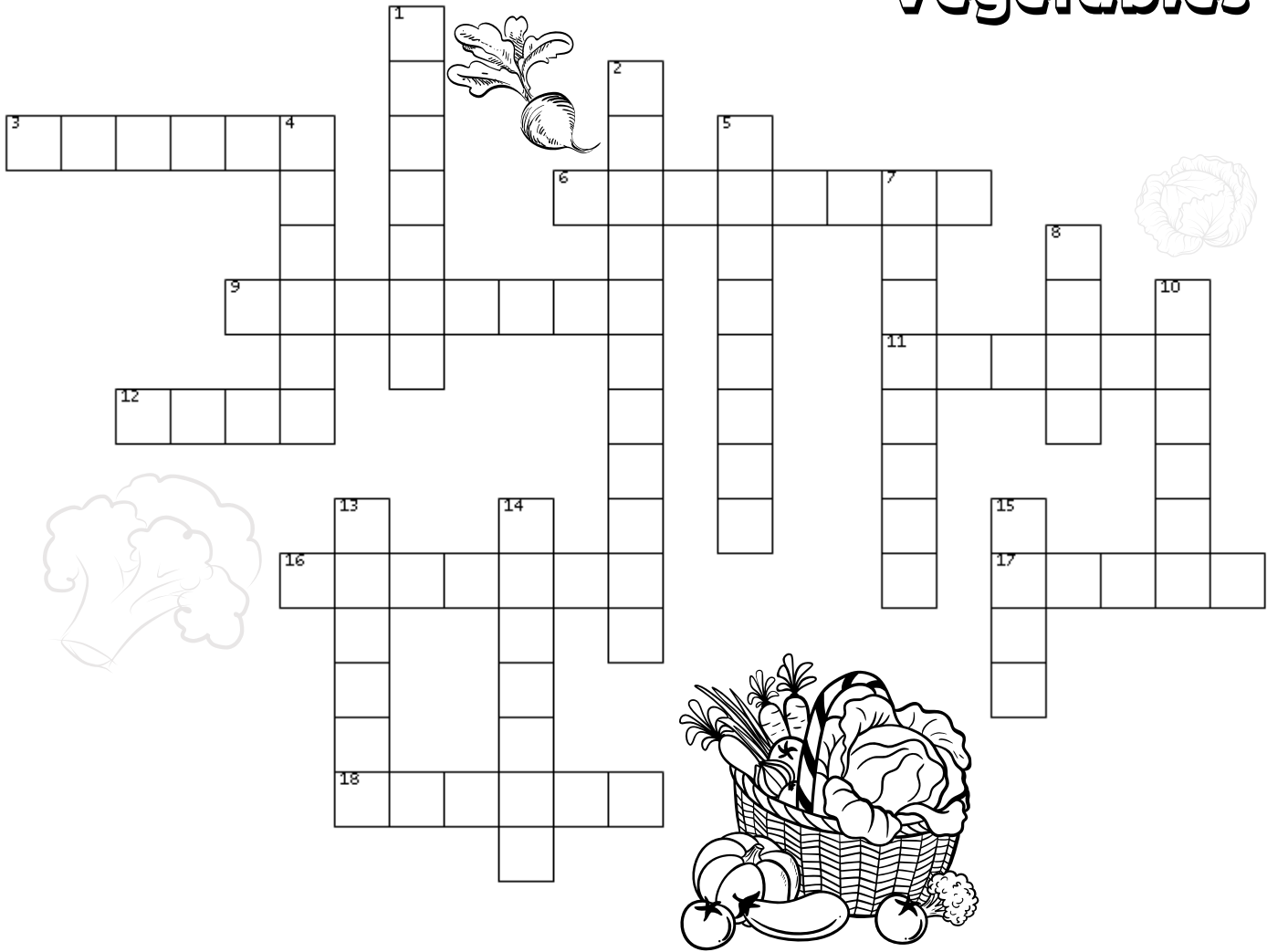


Vegetables



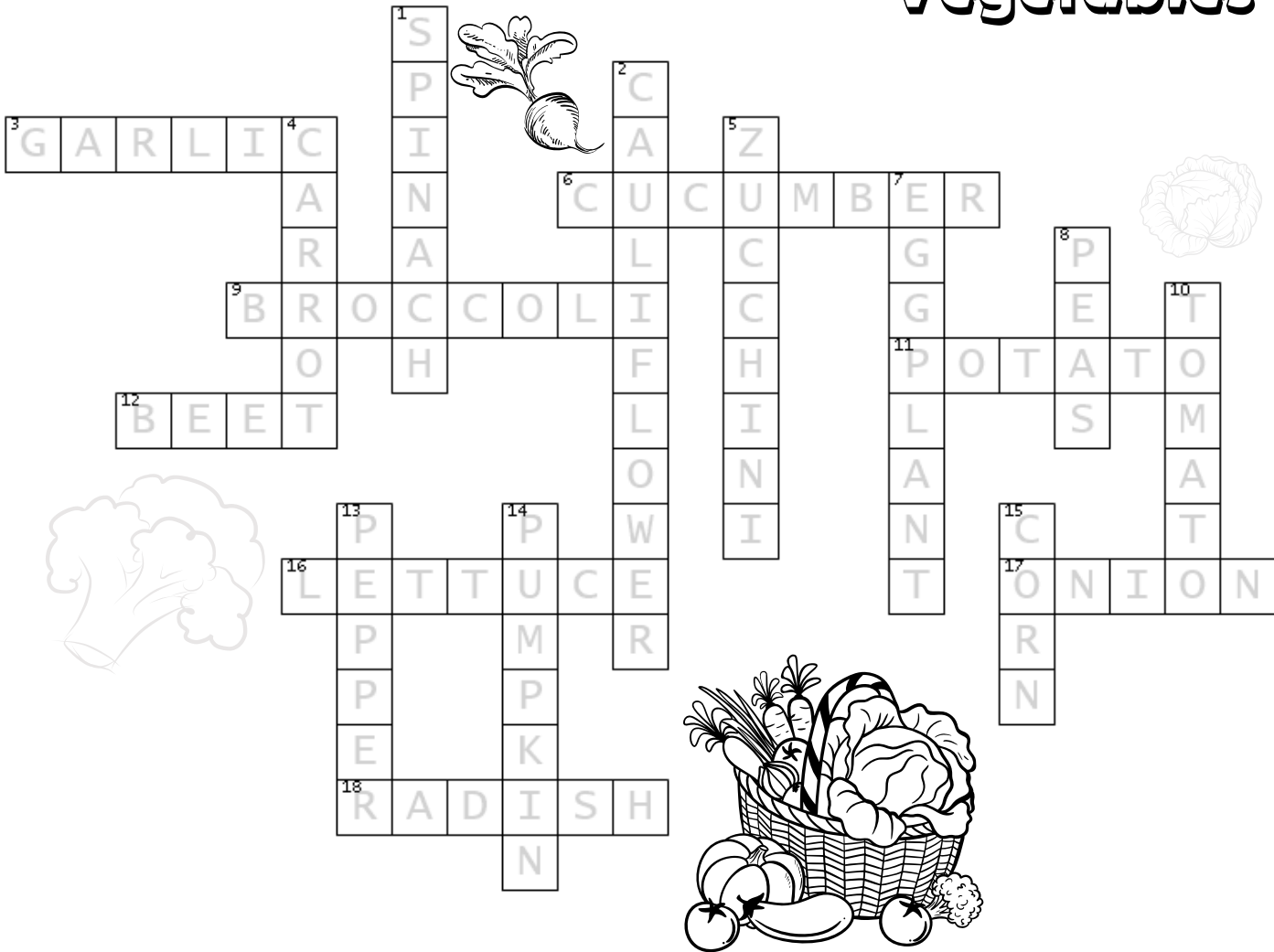
ACROSS
