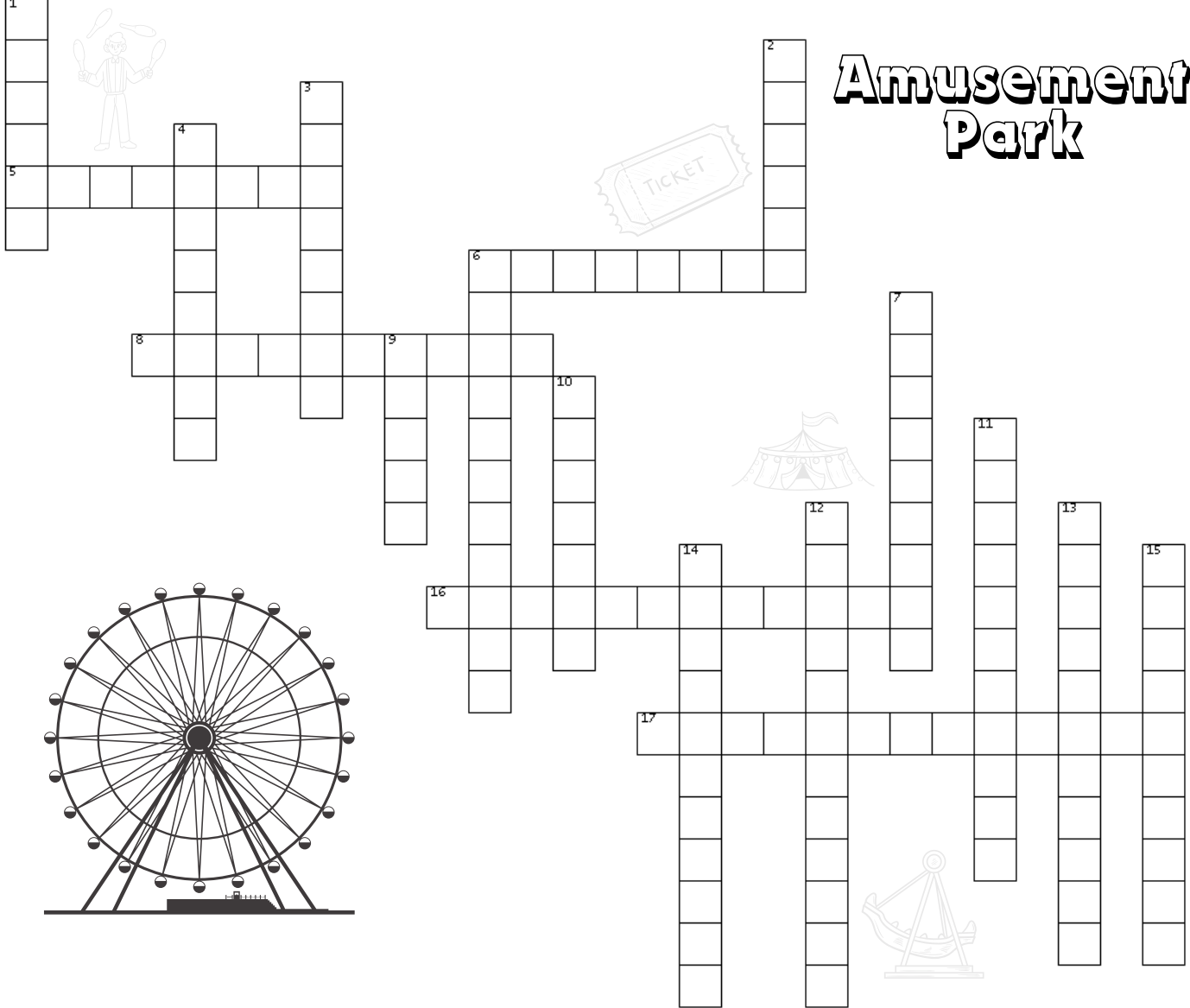


Amusement Park



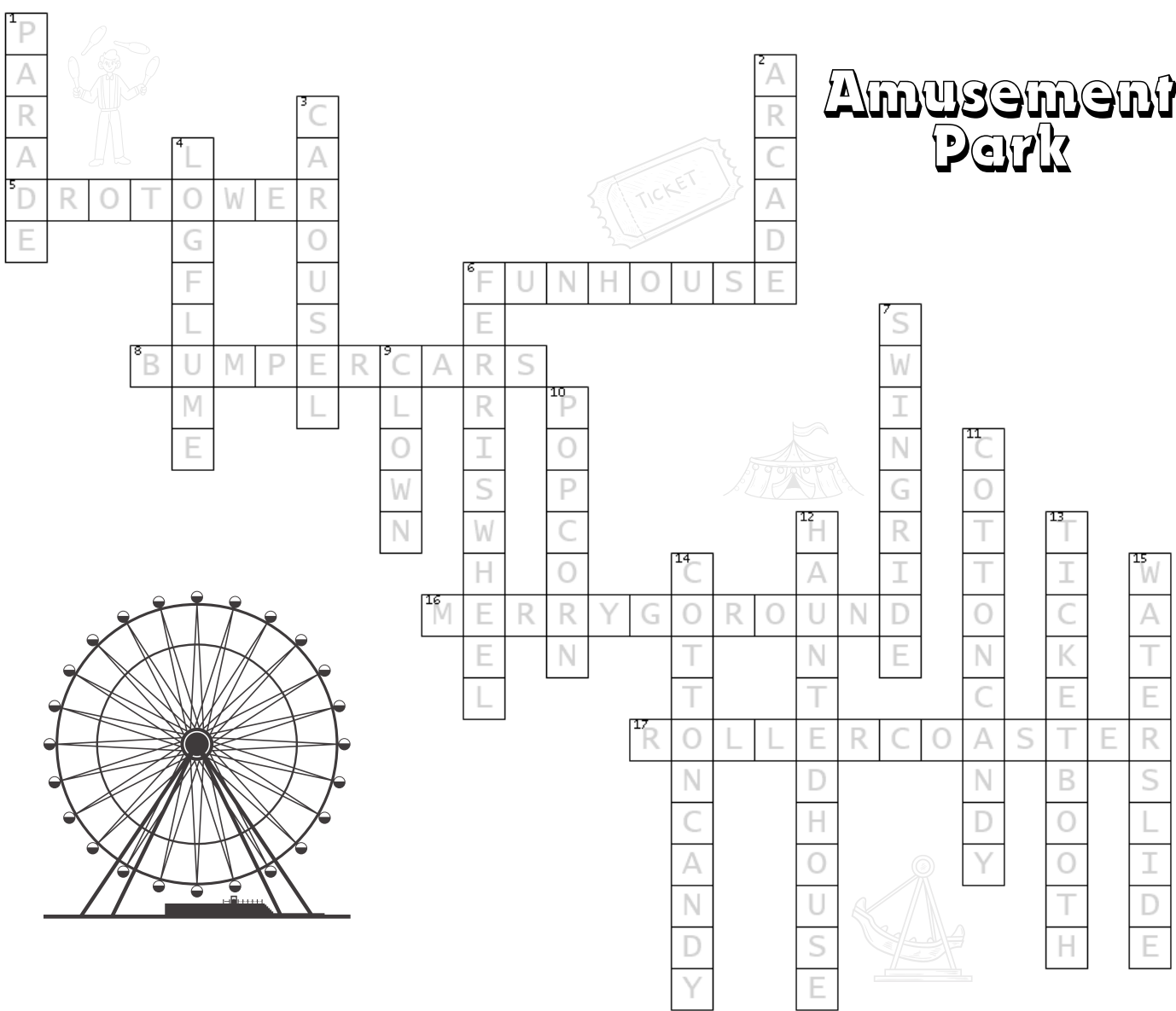
ACROSS

17. A fast ride with steep drops and loops that runs on a track.

DOWN

1. A colorful procession of characters and floats that entertain visitors.
2. A place filled with coinoperated games for people to play.
3. A circular ride with moving horses and other animals that go up and down.
4. A water ride where passengers sit in logshaped boats and splash down hills.
6. A large, rotating wheel with seats that gives a high view of the park.
7. A ride where chairs are attached to a spinning structure, making them fly outward.
9. A colorful character that entertains visitors with jokes and tricks.
10. A salty snack commonly eaten while walking around the park.
11. A light, sweet treat spun from sugar, often sold at parks.
12. A spooky attraction where visitors walk through dark rooms filled with surprises.
13. The place where visitors buy tickets to enter the park or rides.
14. A fluffy, sweet treat often sold at amusement parks.
15. A tall slide that ends in a pool of water, popular in water parks.

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
