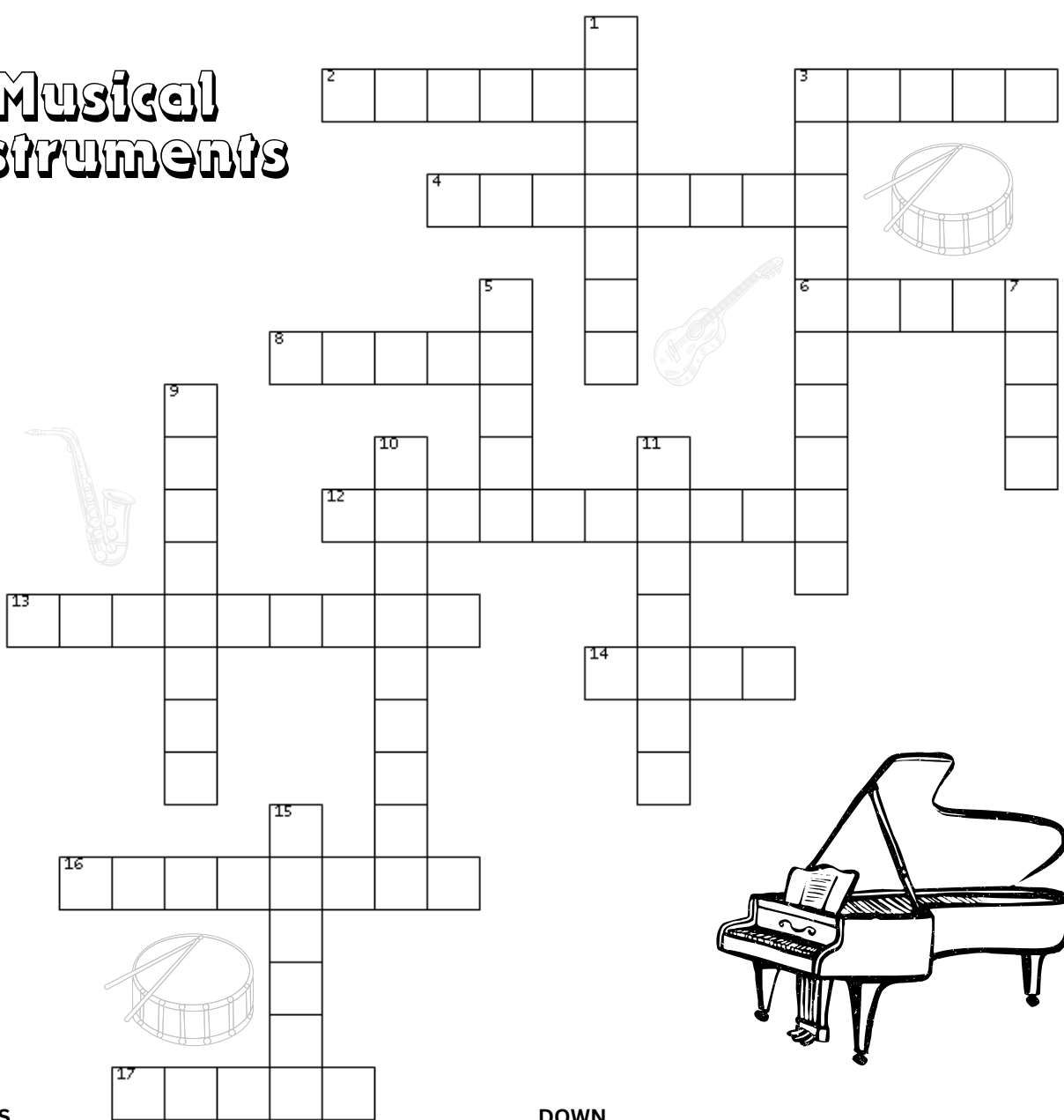


# Musical Instruments



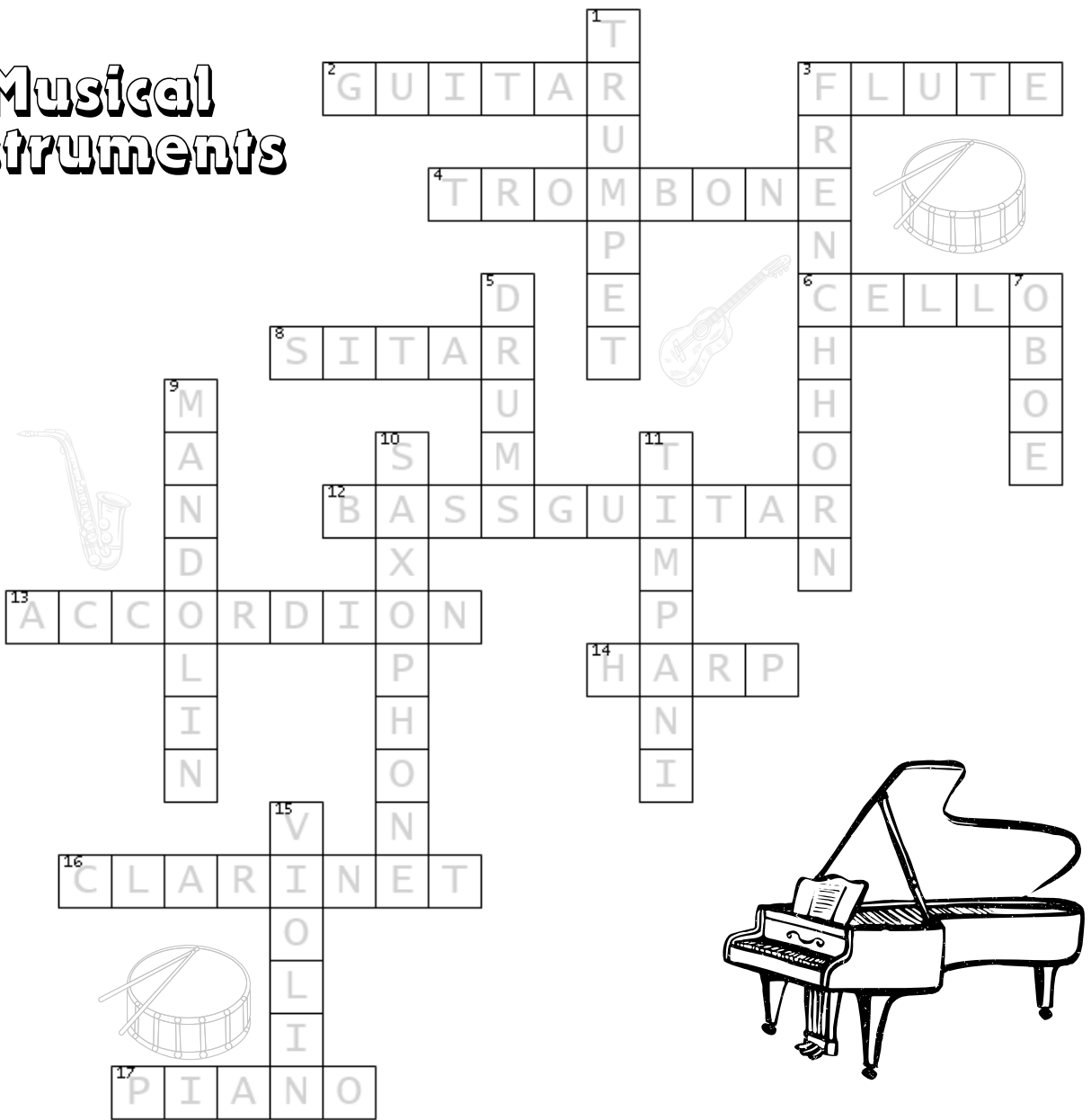
## ACROSS

2. A stringed instrument played by strumming.
3. A woodwind instrument played by blowing air across an opening to produce sound.
4. A brass instrument with a sliding mechanism to change pitch.
6. A large string instrument played while seated.
8. A plucked string instrument from India
12. A stringed instrument similar to a guitar but with a lower pitch and fewer strings.
13. A portable keyboard instrument with bellows that push air through reeds.
14. A stringed instrument with a triangular frame and strings.
16. A woodwind instrument with a single reed mouthpiece and a cylindrical body.
17. A large keyboard instrument with black and white keys.

## DOWN

1. A brass instrument with a flared bell and three valves used in jazz and classical music.
3. A brass instrument with a circular shape and a warm, mellow tone.
5. Percussion instruments that produce sound by being struck with sticks or hands.
7. A woodwind instrument with a doubledreed mouthpiece and a distinctive, penetrating sound.
9. A small, stringed instrument with a fretted neck, usually played with a plectrum.
10. A woodwind instrument made of brass with a singlereed mouthpiece.
11. Large kettledrums that can be tuned to different pitches, often used in orchestras.
15. A bowed string instrument known for its high pitch and four strings.

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
