BRACHIOSAURUS ANSWER SHEET

- 1. The Brachiosaurus lived around 154 million years ago in the Jurassic period.
- 2. The Brachiosaurus had longer front legs than back legs, causing its body to slope upwards towards its neck.
- 3. The Brachiosaurus could grow to be 85 feet long and 40 feet tall.
- 4. The Brachiosaurus was a herbivore and ate plants like ferns, conifers, and tall trees.
- 5. Its long neck allowed it to reach high up into the top of trees where most other dinosaurs couldn't reach.
- 6. The Brachiosaurus lived in what is now North America, which was full of forests, rivers, and marshes.
- 7. The Brachiosaurus likely went extinct due to changing climate, new predators, and changes in vegetation during the late Jurassic period.
- 8. The Brachiosaurus's neck was 30 feet long.
- 9. The name "Brachiosaurus" comes from the Greek words "brachion" (arm) and "sauros" (lizard), referring to its long front legs that looked like arms.
