## DILOPHOSAURUS ANSWER SHEET

- 1. The Dilophosaurus lived in the early Jurassic period, about 193 million years ago.
- 2. The Dilophosaurus could grow up to 7 meters long and 2 meters tall.
- 3. The Dilophosaurus hunted by using its sharp teeth and powerful legs to chase and grab prey.
- 4. The Dilophosaurus was a carnivore and likely ate smaller dinosaurs and possibly fish.
- 5. The Dilophosaurus had bony bumps, called crests, on its head.
- 6. The Dilophosaurus could run up to 30 miles per hour.
- 7. The Dilophosaurus lived in what we now call North America.
- 8. The name "Dilophosaurus" means "two-crested lizard" in Greek.
